#### **OBJECTIVES:**

In accordance with the requirements under the Companies Act, 2013, the objective of the CSR policy is to lay down the guidelines for the company to make CSR a business process for sustainable development of the society. The policy aims to enhance and implement the society welfare measures by the company in a structured manner on short term and long-term basis with a vision of making HTL Group to act as a Good Corporate Citizen.

Areas that are covered as part CSR activities are:

#### **EDUCATION:**

Promoting education, including special education and employmentenhancing vocational skills especially among children, women, elderly and the differently abled, and livelihood enhancement projects; monetary contributions to academic institutions for establishing endowment funds, chairs, laboratories, etc., with the objective of assisting students in their studies

### **HEALTH CARE AND WELLBEING:**

- Preventive and promote health care and sanitation and making available safe drinking water through mobile medical vans etc
- Nutritional supplements to lactating mothers, children, adolescent girls and pregnant women.
- Donating medical infrastructure to local hospitals and primary health centers
- Health awareness campaigns on serious/chronic diseases.
- Organizing periodic health and blood donation camps at various locations

#### **ENVIRONMENT:**

Ensuring environmental sustainability, ecological balance, protection of flora and fauna, animal welfare, agro-forestry, conservation of natural resources and maintaining the quality of soil, air and water.

#### **RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS:**

Strengthening rural areas by improving accessibility, housing, drinking water, sanitation, power and livelihoods, thereby creating sustainable villages.
